## WCMA Philippines – Ondoy Flood Relief Mission

In mid September 2009 the Philippine Islands were struck by a series of tropical storms including Typhoon Qndoy. They caused extensive flooding. The Philippine province of Rizal, the largest in the country, was exceptionally hard hit.

Angono is the capital of Rizal provence and by chance the Angono General Hospital, is where the WCMA's Philippine medical missions are held. This hospital is the province's most important medical facility and was flooded by the storms as was much of Angono, Please see the attached photographs to get an idea of the extent of the flooding.

The WCMA organized a relief effort that included shipping an EKG machine and a sonograph machine to the Angono General Hospital. In addition, the WCMA sent over 500 pounds of medical supplies to help the hospital recover from the flooding.

A small delegation from the WCMA visited the Philippines in November taking additional medical supplies and \$6,000 to purchase food and medicines locally for the flood victims. It is interesting to note that the TMAA actually participated in this effort since the \$250 prize that the WCMA received for winning the TMAA 2008/2009 Global Service Award was part of \$6,000.

The mayor of Angono personally thanked the WCMA for its assistance in helping with recovery from the flooding. Please see the attached official letter of appreciation. Also attached is a photograph of the WCMA banner in a post flood parade in Angono.

Independently and simultaneously with the above effort the WCMA donated medical supplies to the hospital on Colon Island. Approximately 2,000 pounds of medical supplies were shipped to the hospital on that remote island for use in treating the poor.
